

**Bachelor of Arts (Double Major)**

1. The arts core (30h)
2. A minimum of 42h in one arts subject, mathematics, or psychology, to satisfy first major requirements. (Departments may require more than 42h)
3. A minimum of 36h in one subject to satisfy second major requirements. (Departments may require more than 36h).
4. Elective courses to complete a total of 120h.
5. Except where the second major is taken in the Faculty of Professional Studies, 96h must be taken in the faculties of arts and science.

Arts subjects that may be offered for the first major are Canadian studies, classics, economics, English, French, German, history, Latin, philosophy, political science, sociology, Spanish, and theatre studies. Women's studies and any subject may be offered for the second major. Courses offered to satisfy each of the major requirements must be completed with a C- or better. In any case at least 84h must be completed with a C- or better.

- A program GPA of 2.0 is required in order to be eligible to graduate
