Women's Studies emphasizes the importance of gender as a category of analysis in scholarly activity, social relations, cultural expression, and political systems. Students are encouraged to examine established theoretical frameworks as well as feminist alternatives, and to evaluate assumptions about gender incorporated into institutions, ideologies, history, human nature, science, language and culture.
